The SEPTA cuts, AI 'traffic enforcement' cameras on buses, and ongoing vehicular homicides of bicyclists are just some of the latest faces in this city of the attacks everywhere on freedom of movement. Power coerces us into dependency on its infrastructure, and almost fools many into identifying with it, believing it makes them free. But this nation and the global systems it's part of have always been built on forced movement and confinement, from the slave trade and genocide of indigenous peoples to the Holocaust, the genocide of Palestinians, and the colonial slaughter for iPhone and Cybertruck-fueling rare-earth minerals. Whether stuck in traffic, scrolling, at work, in prison, or swept along in the restructurings and flows of Capital, technological development, and the State, the all-consuming, devouring needs of Civilization are eroding the paths of our lives. Even the movements and becomings of our bodies and minds are disciplined, as the public, daily violence of cis-hetero-patriarchy, the drug war, and the propaganda machine make clear. The positionally-destabilizing movements of revolutionary solidarity reaching across the globe or across identity positions come under particular assault. Many look away or convince themselves that the progressive spirit of reform at Civilization's heart can function without such horrors, and is in our real interest... But some of us still see the glitches in this uncanny succession of machine-generated images.

At the turnstile, on the bus, through taxes, and wherever else we can.

We won't defend this metropolis that pollutes our lives. We won't make suggestions for how it, and the national and international systems of domination fueling and fueled by it, could be administered 'better', or for how they use what they steal from us. We won't work for pennies, and we won't let any union of pathetic compromises sell us to the bosses in our name. We won't be anyone's volunteer snitches or tax-collectors. We reject all 'green', 'humanitarian', 'progressive' promises of development, false consensus-building, policing, and technological dystopia. We see clearly the velvet glove's false opposition to authoritarianism and fascism. We know that the only glimmers of possibility lie on the other side of attack, sabotage, and expropriation. We are committed to the insurrectional project that deliberately, directly, reproducibly acts to effectively generalize and deepen the cracks of anarchy towards joy, liberation, and the unknown, through affinity groups and horizontal, informal organization, existing not as ends in themselves but only within specific insurgent interventions and sites of popular struggle, as unique, autonomous equals amidst the crucial but recuperable processes of mass revolt.

Because the conveyor belts of our daily commutes never takes us anywhere. Because we are sick of living between a series of cubes and screens.

We intend to go where it pleases us in our lives, and to waylay the flows of their resources and forces of control in order to do so.
